The Texas Department of Agriculture <u>requires</u> applicants to complete the "Private Applicator Training" course (Sec. 76.112 of the Texas Department of Agriculture Laws and Regulations). The training usually takes 4 (four) hours to complete.

* How are you taking the <u>required</u> "Private Applicator Training" course?

Online (materials are automatically shipped with the course therefore you do not need to purchase separately)

In-Person (have you contacted your nearest county Extension office to see if they provide the materials Y/N)

If you are taking the training in-person, after contacting your county Extension office and it is determined that they do not provide the materials, then it is recommended that you purchase your study materials in advance to allow time for reviewing the manuals and worksheets as well as complete the exercises before your training date to insure success on the examination.

Private Applicator licenses are renewed every 5 (five) years, the current fee for this license is \$100. Each licensed private applicator must obtain 15 (fifteen) CEUs within the 5 (five) year period including at least two credits in laws and regulations and two credits in integrated pest management to maintain their license.
